Presto Preservation Association Board of Directors Meeting Minutes 24 April 2021

The minutes of the previous meeting of February 20, 2021, were approved, with addition of the following Financial Report:

Account Balances (March 13, 2021):

 House Restoration Account: \$5,121.75
 PayPal: \$2,171.44

FINANCIAL REPORT: The Report was provided by Wendy Pratt via email and was accepted by the Board.

Account Balances (April 24, 2021):

General Account: \$14,944.92
House Restoration Account: \$5,121.75
PayPal: \$2,171.44

Wendy noted that the *Association* pays: \$199 twice per year for the *Ancestry.com* subscription; \$29.95/year to access *Newspapers.com*; and \$125/year for Sustaining Membership in the *Bingham County Historical Society*.

OLD BUSINESS:

- <u>Presto Press</u>: Rick provided some brief information about the upcoming issue, which will include memories of Ladene Gough.
- Membership Committee: Emma provided a membership update and anticipates renewals.
- <u>Fundraising Update:</u> Ginger and Charlie have not yet developed a formal *Fundraising Plan*. Debbie proposed pricing caramels along with membership dues as follows: half pound for \$50 or one pound for \$100, which can be purchased in person or online. Ginger and Charlie will meet and develop a formal *Plan* by the *Presto Press* publication deadline of June 1st.
- Just-Reid for Home Cooking Cookbook: Roy and Rick are nearly ready to place an order for Cookbooks.
- Bingham County Historical Society: Sustaining Membership in the Society has been renewed for one year.
- <u>National Register of Historic Places</u>: Rick estimates a cost of about \$800 to place a designation plaque at the Just House. He will forward proposals to the Board for approval.
- Memorial Window Plaques: Betsy will obtain plaques and they will be placed before the 2021 Reunion.

NELS AND EMMA JUST HOUSE RESTORATION AND PRESERVATION:

- Kathy announced that Abstract Masonry Restoration is scheduled to begin the next phase of brick/mortar/plaster restoration on June 28, 2021. Becky will schedule a Porta-Potty for workers and obtain more sand.
- Tell-a-Story: Follow-up by Becky and Wendy; tabled.
- <u>Window Restoration</u>: Becky provided a status report on window restoration. Rick suggested that the Chick Just window may be restored in memory of Kent Just.

- <u>Walkway to House</u>: After review of options, Joel motioned to approve the purchase of materials and fund the project after completion of brick restoration work. Becky seconded, and the motion was unanimously approved.
- <u>Window Blinds</u>: As per previous approval by the Board, Debbie will obtain/install *period* window blinds for two designated windows to reduce sun damage to house contents and window frames. The cost of the blinds will not exceed an estimated cost of \$150-\$200 and will be paid from the *General Account*.
- Rain Gutter: Becky has obtained a rain gutter; she will follow-up with Ken Davis to install the gutter.
- <u>Plaster Restoration (Interior)</u>: Kathy will research options for obtaining an historic plaster restoration company to restore the interior plaster at some point in the future.
- <u>Windmill Blades</u>: Jared Reid has asked for photos of the original windmill to determine the size of blades; attendees will look for photos and forward to Jared.
- Floor Repair: Becky will send before/after photos of the repairs to Rick.
- Return of Log Barn/Shop to Original Site: The Barn/Shop will be moved from Megan's property; discussion
 ensued regarding options for removing the barn from its current location. Becky and Debbie will
 follow-up per discussion. A previous proposal to seek a grant to assist with this project was tabled.

REUNION and SESQUICENTENNIAL+1 EVENT (August 13-15,2021):

- The Board unanimously approved a proposal to hold the Reunion and Sesquicentennial+1 Event in August.
- Betsy will work with Joel and Ginger to finalize a design and obtain price quotes for souvenirs that will be sold and/or auctioned at the Reunion. The items considered include, but are not limited to, reusable shopping bags, dish towels, Yeti Brand cups, and hats. A proposal, including a budget, will be submitted to the Board by May 24, 2021, for approval by an e-mail vote.
- The book, Letters of Long Ago, could be added to the auction, since we have plenty of copies; however, Rick reported that we only have one copy of Lost Letters. Rick will add Lost Letters to Amazon.com for purchase and will also have hard copies available at the Reunion if the cost is not too prohibitive.
- An assignment sheet for the Reunion was attached to the agenda; Kathy requested that Directors review the listing for assignments.
- Discussion ensued regarding the Sesquicentennial+1 event. Debbie presented sample name tag lanyards and family tree posters. Joel agreed to provide lanyards for the Reunion and will send a logo to the Board for approval. Debbie and Joel will follow-up.
- Debbie announced that a photographer will be available at the Reunion to take family photos, and Carol Honas will video highlights of the Reunion.
- Jared Reid plans to use a drone to record video footage of the Reunion.

- Rick proposed that the Association donate 30 copies of Letters of Long Ago to Charlotte Reid for use in an 11th
